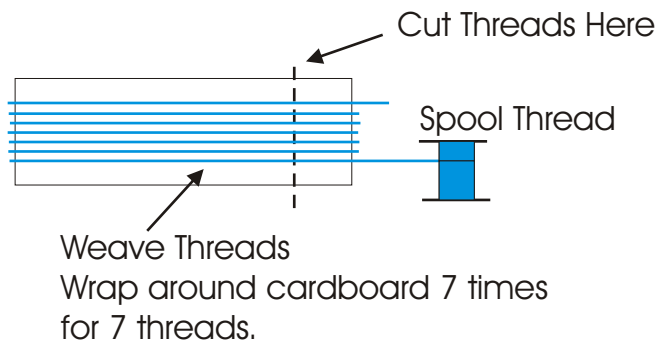


Weaving Names

1st Making Weave Threads:

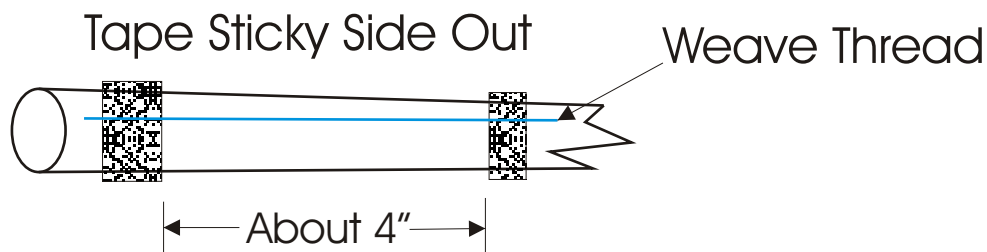
Determine the length of threads you need. Usually 8" will do the job. Take a 4" x 3" piece of cardboard and wrap the weave thread around the cardboard lengthwise. One complete wrap around for each thread. For normal letters you need 7. Then cut all threads at one end of the cardboard. You now have 7 8" weave threads.



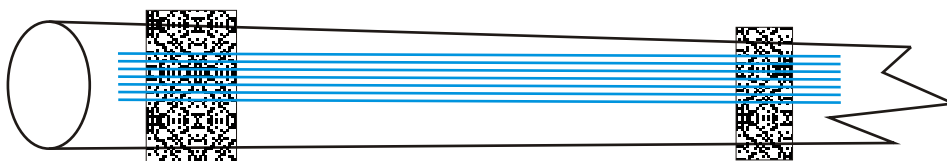
2nd Making Tape Collars:

Make tape collars on both sides of where your weave will go. About 1" past each end. Make the sticky side out. Most name weaves can be done in 4" between collars.

3rd After determining size, start by laying a thread in the middle of the tape collar. Use this thread to line up the center. Now lay one on each side and repeat until all threads are down

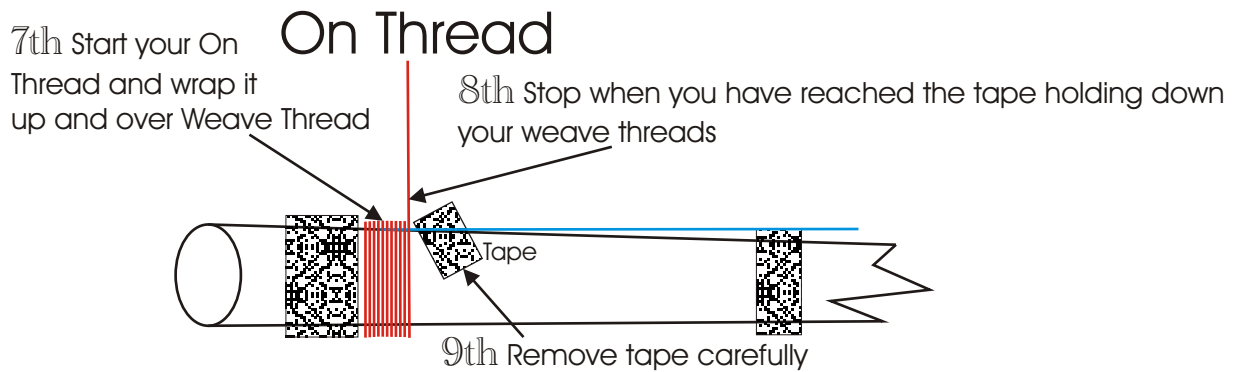
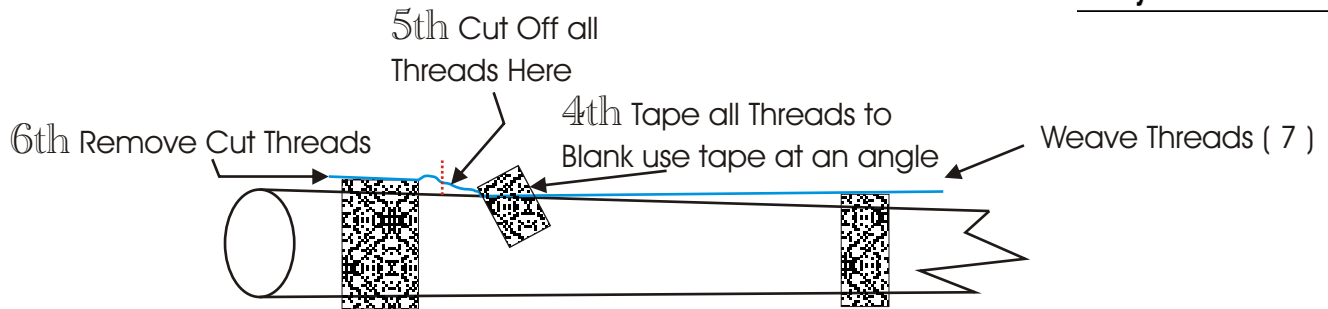


EXAMPLE OF WEAVE THREADS LAID ON BLANK

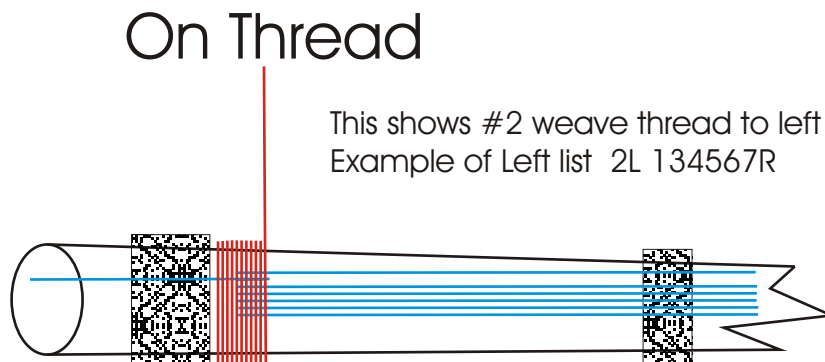
10th Start Your Weave:

Now do the first step in your weave pattern.

Example: 123L 4567R This means threads 1,2,3 will be placed to the left tape collar and 4,5,6,7 will remain on the right collar. Now turn the blank 1 revolution.

This completes revolution 1. Remember " do " means do the last revolution again.

Leave 3 revolutions between letters.



11th at the end:

Cut off weave threads and wrap on thread past weave threads 3 revolutions then add the pull string 4 more revolutions and pull your on thread under to finish.
